Located on the Niagara River at Lewis St., in the beautiful town of Fort Erie, Ontario, Canada. Actual address is 560 Niagara Blvd, Fort Erie, L2A 6V6, Like the name implies, the “Underwater Recovery Unit” was originally founded to facilitate the recovery of property and persons lost in the areas watercourses. Today the Recovery Unit functions as a **Non-Profit, SCUBA club** with diving interests ranging from shallow river to deep lake and ocean diving. When requested, the Recovery Unit will engage in a community service operation. Club members may **volunteer** to assist in these operations if they wish.

The Recovery Unit is a non profit organization and has it's own club house which it leases from the Town of Fort Erie. Members have use of all club property including air compressor, NITROX, Zodiac boat and motor, dry suits, tanks, regulators, dive computers etc.

The club has many functions. Group Dive trips, Bar-B-Qs, video nights and diver training , Supply of safety coverage for Winterfest events in the winter for their Polar Bear Dip. Our group has also provided information sessions and entertainment for the Town Library evening shows.

Membership is open to all certified divers. Family membership is also welcome and encouraged. Unit meetings are held Second Sunday 10:00 AM Jan through May and second Wednesdays 7:00 PM. each month in summer June through Oct.
